The Huber Heights Firefighters Local 2926 have set the bar for third-party fundraising for Pink Ribbon Girls. Over the past four years, their "Go Pink or Go Home" campaign has raised over \$230,000 for direct services for women and their families battling breast cancer right here in the Miami Valley. Their passion has gained explosive local and national media attention for not only their efforts, but for Pink Ribbon Girls.

Pink Ribbon Girls is a 501(c)(3) organization whose mission is to balance the fear and uncertainty that breast cancer brings to individuals and families by providing direct services, education, and support. Through our Simply Fight! and NO Age NO Stage programs in the Cincinnati and Dayton metro areas, Pink Ribbon Girls provides FREE meals, housekeeping, transportation to treatment and peer support to patients and their families undergoing breast cancer treatment.

As you can see, Pink Ribbon Girls continues to grow exponentially. It is our goal to one day provide services nationwide!

Our community has such a positive response to seeing the men and women who pledge to protect and serve our citizens through their service through their local fire departments.
